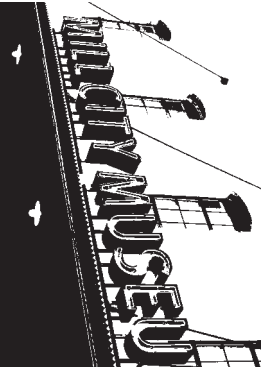

Minneapolis and the Age of Railways

Thursday, Nov. 3, 2005, 7 p.m. FREE

Mill City Museum's monthly program series continues with a talk, book signing and new exhibit about Minneapolis during the railroad era. Don L. Hoffsummer will give a presentation and sign copies of his new book "Minneapolis & the Age of Railways," a history of Minneapolis from the 1860s to the 1950s, when railroads provided the link between Minneapolis, the region and the rest of the world. The museum also will open a new exhibit, "Railroads and the Marketing of the Northwest." The exhibit will feature railroad advertising images promoting the land and natural beauty of Minnesota, the Dakotas and Montana.

The exhibit will be on display until April 30, 2006, and is free and open to the public during regular museum hours.
